

GreenWay construction notice

Removal of temporary water main on Longport Street, Lewisham

Night work

for one night between the dates of

Tuesday 20 January and Friday 30 January 2026

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. We have opened the GreenWay shared path in December last year.

As part of the final phase of construction, we are removing a temporary water main on Longport Street bridge in Lewisham. Works include concrete works and pavement restoration.

When will the night work take place?

The night work will take place for one night only, from 9pm to 5am between the dates of Tuesday 20 January and Friday 30 January 2026 (weather permitting).

What will be done to minimise inconvenience to me?

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works. Traffic measures will be in place during the night work.
