Installation of traffic lights on Old Canterbury Road

Extended night works

Monday 24 November to Thursday 4 December 2025

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. This exciting project is in its final stages and will open soon.

As part of the GreenWay, we are installing traffic lights on Old Canterbury Road near Edward Street and Weston Street to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.

We have had extend night works to ensure the project is completed without unnecessary delay.

When will these night works take place?

Additional night works will take place on Old Canterbury Road from Monday 24 November to Thursday 4 December (weather permitting).

Regular day time works are also occurring and are anticipated to be completed by early December (weather permitting).

What will be done to minimise inconvenience to me?

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works. Traffic measures will be in place on Old Canterbury Road during the night works.
