GreenWay construction notice

Installation of traffic lights on Old Canterbury Road and the closure of Weston Street in Dulwich Hill

Monday 22 September to late November 2025

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. This exciting project is in its final stages and will open soon.

As part of the GreenWay, we are undertaking works on Old Canterbury Road (near Edward Street) and on Weston Street (near Old Canterbury Road) to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.

The works will include:

- The introduction of a pedestrian and cyclist crossing over Old Canterbury Road between Edward Street and Weston Street.
- The installation of traffic lights and a right-hand turning lane into Edward Street going west on Old Canterbury Road.
- A new median strip on Old Canterbury Road near McGill Street.
- The closure of Weston Street to vehicles at Old Canterbury Road.

When will these works take place?

Works will start on Monday 22 September and are anticipated to be completed by late November (weather permitting). These work hours will take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

There will also be one week of night works on Old Canterbury Road from Monday 22 September (weather permitting). These work hours will take place from 5pm to 7am.

What impacts can I expect?

To reduce disruption to residents, the works will be carried out in stages.

The following impacts can be expected:

Creation of Weston Street cul-de-sac:

To increase pedestrian and cyclist safety, the entry to Weston Street off Old Canterbury Road will be permanently closed to vehicle traffic from Monday 29 September (weather permitting) to allow for a slow street to be created as part of the GreenWay.

Loss of parking on Old Canterbury Road:

There will be a permanent loss of parking spaces on Old Canterbury Road to allow for the right-hand turning lane. Please refer to the design plan attached to this letter.

Temporary relocation of the bus stop

The bus stop on Old Canterbury Road near Edward Street will be temporarily relocated a short distance away to allow for the works to be completed.

Temporary closure of Edward Street:

Edward Street will be temporarily closed to vehicle traffic from late September to late November (weather permitting). Detours and signage will be in place during this time.

Temporary loss of parking:

There will be a temporary loss of parking at the following locations from late September to the end of November (weather permitting):

- Parking spaces directly outside properties 115 to 123 Old Canterbury Road.
- The two parking spaces on Edward Street, adjacent to 122 Old Canterbury Road.
- Some parking spaces on Old Canterbury Road near Edward Street, due to the temporary relocation of the existing bus stop.
- Parking spaces on the bridge over the light rail (between Waratah Mills and Lewisham West) on Old Canterbury Road.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience to me?

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works.

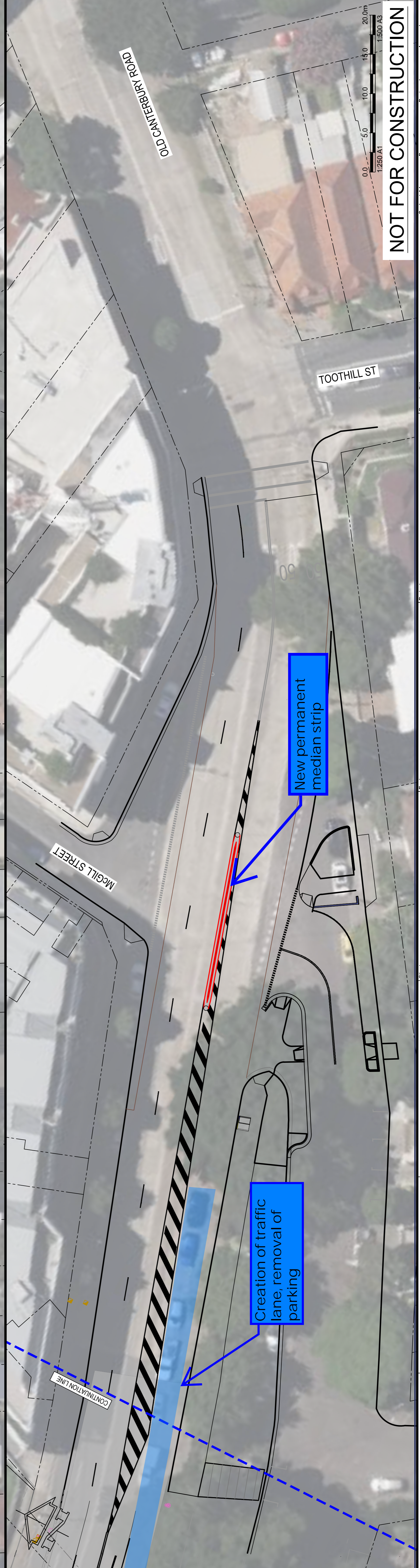
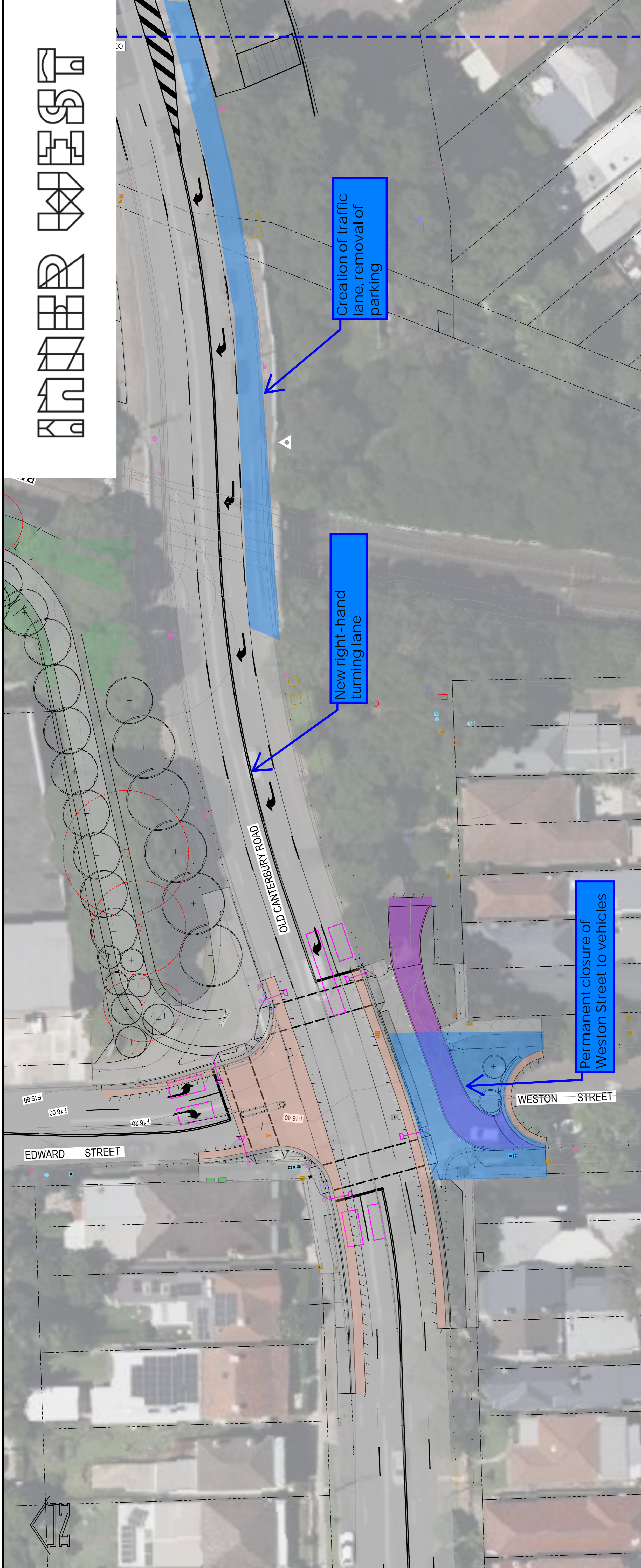
Footpath detours will be in place at different stages of the construction period. Signage will help guide pedestrians and cyclists during this time.
