



GreenWay construction notice

Upgrades to Smith Street Roundabout, Summer Hill Monday 28 April to late June 2025

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. As part of the GreenWay construction, the roundabout in Summer Hill connecting Smith Street, Carlton Crescent, Grosvenor Crescent and Longport Street, will undergo construction works to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.

Where will the construction take place?

Construction will take place on Smith Street, Carlton Crescent and Grosvenor Crescent adjacent to the roundabout. The works require temporary road and footpath closures on these streets.

What type of work is being done?

The works will include the continuation of the pedestrian and cyclist shared footpath, new pedestrian refuge islands, reconstruction of the existing kerbs and gutters, and stormwater infrastructure upgrades.

When will these works take place?

Works will commence from Monday 28 April 2025 and will take approximately two months to complete (weather permitting).

These works will be undertaken in stages to help minimise as much impact to residents as possible.


What will be done to minimise inconvenience to me?

Short detours will be in place and signage will be placed on site to help guide pedestrians and cyclists during the different stages of construction.

Vehicle detours will also be in place, as per below.

All resident driveways and access roads in the Flour Mills precinct will remain accessible.

Vehicle detours for stage 2 (Carlton Crescent closure) and stage 3 (Grosvenor Crescent closure) will be published on innerwest.nsw.gov.au/GreenWayUpdates towards the end of April.

The contractor will undertake mitigation measures in accordance with their Construction Environmental Management Plan to reduce noise, dust, and debris associated with these works.
