

INNER WEST LIGHT RAIL SHUTDOWN

Friday 5 July 5pm to Monday 8 July 7am

GreenWay night and weekend construction works

To enable construction of the GreenWay, including construction of the GreenWay path and ecological restoration of the corridor, weekend and night construction work has been scheduled during the closure of the Inner West light rail line.

Where will the works be undertaken?

The works will be undertaken near Dulwich Grove light rail station, along the western side of the light rail corridor between New Canterbury Road and Hercules Street in Dulwich Hill. The adjacent roads, Hercules Street and New Canterbury Road, will be used to provide access to the works area.

Closure of path

The pedestrian and cycling path along the western side of Dulwich Grove light rail station will be closed from Wednesday 19 June for approximately 2 months. Detours and traffic management will be in place (see map overleaf).

What type of work is being done?

A concrete substructure to support the elevated boardwalk in Dulwich Grove will be constructed during the light rail shutdown weekend. This includes installation of piles to support the new shared boardwalk, excavation works, minor tree pruning and removal of spoil offsite.

When will the work be undertaken?

The GreenWay construction works will be undertaken continuously day and night between Friday 5 July 5pm and Monday 8 July 7am, during the light rail shutdown. The time constraint of the light rail shutdown weekend means that contractors need to work continuously during the light rail shutdown hours to safely complete the piling works.

Construction access during the light rail shutdown works will be via New Canterbury Road.

Preparation works 19 June – 5 July

Preparation works will be undertaken in the Dulwich Grove light rail and footpath area from Wednesday 19 June to Friday 5 July during regular construction hours, 7am to 5pm Monday

to Friday. These preparation works include setting up site amenities, installation of temporary fencing, removal of bollards, and preparation of the site.

Construction access during the preparation works will be via Hercules Street.

Post light rail shutdown works 8 July to late August

Post light rail shutdown works are scheduled to take place from Monday 8 July to approximately late August (pending weather delays) during regular construction hours, 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday. These works include detailed work on the piles and works to facilitate reinstating the path for public access.

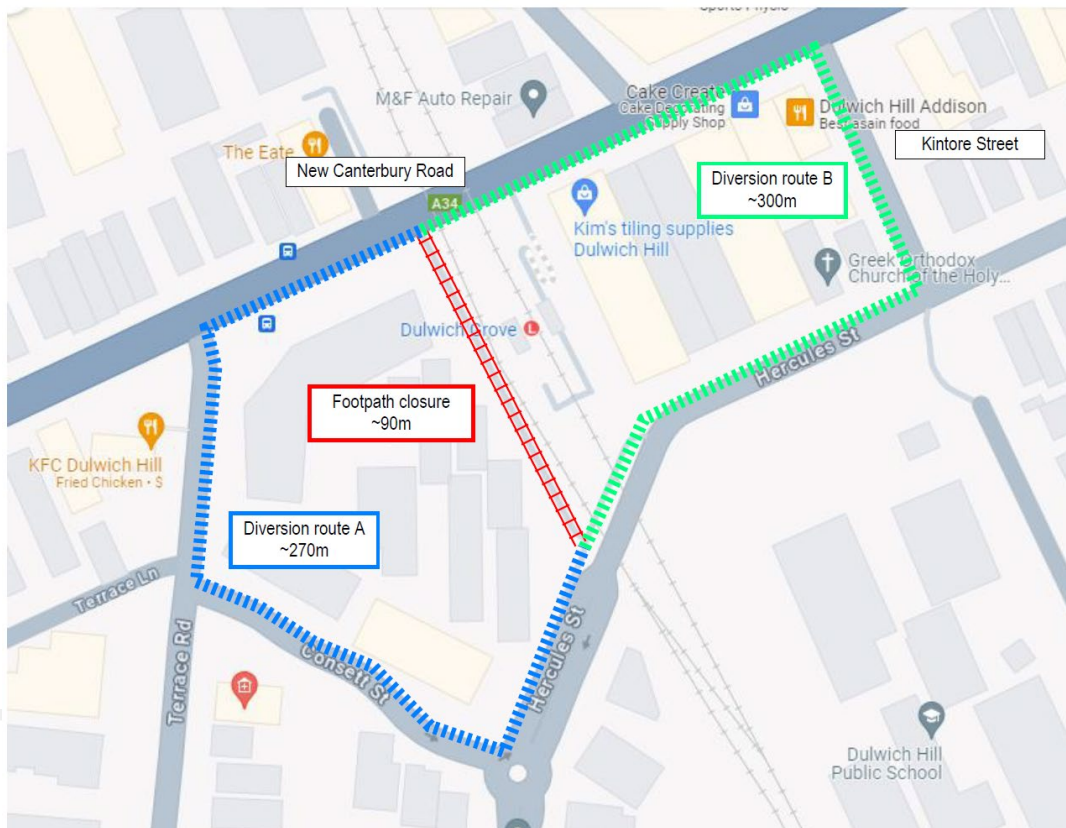
Construction access during the post light rail shutdown works will be via Hercules Street.

What will be done to minimise inconvenience for me?

Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with equipment and machinery by GreenWay contractors. The smallest possible piling machinery will be used for piling works. Light towers will be pointed away from adjoining properties, sediment fencing, and dust mitigation practices are in place.

State utility agencies will also be undertaking works in the light rail corridor at the same time and will provide separate notification to this letter.
