

## **Works and temporary closure notice**

### **Returfing of Lewisham West dog off leash area**

As part of maintenance improvements, we are installing new and more durable grass in the Lewisham West dog off-leash area.

We originally installed Sapphire Soft Leaf Buffalo grass, which we are now upgrading to Santa Ana Couch, a stronger, high-performance sports turf that offers greater durability, particularly in heavily used areas such as dog parks.

#### **When will these works take place?**

Installation of the new grass will start on Monday 1 December 2025 and takes about five days to complete (weather permitting).

Work hours: 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

#### **Temporary closure of the dog off leash areas**

We are installing the new grass in stages, so half of the dog off leash area can stay open to the public at all times, while the other half is closed for maintenance.

After the new turf is installed, the grass will need time to establish.

- Stage 1 closure: Monday 1 December 2025 to mid-February 2026
- Stage 2 closure: late February to early April 2026

We appreciate your patience whilst we deliver these important maintenance works.

## Alternative dog off leash areas

There are several dog off-leash areas available nearby for use during this time.

Nearby dog off leash areas:

- Petersham Park – Petersham
- Morton Park – Lewisham
- Hoskins Park – Dulwich Hill, until mid-December 2025
- Johnson Park – Dulwich Hill, from mid-December 2025
