




PLAN KEY

- 3 Park seating
- 4 New fitness station
- 5 Existing drinking fountain to be retained, and provided with accessible path
- 6 New multiplay tower
- 7 New see saw rocker
- 8 New rocker
- 9 Existing swing to be retained with new seats
- 10 Existing chin up to be retained
- 11 Nature play
- 12 Open grassed area
- 13 Existing grassed area to be protected
- 14 Mulch at base of existing trees

EV Kerbside Charging Grant

- 3 EV kerbside charging partners – EVX, EVSE and PLUS ES
- Delivered 150 charging ports from 2024
- Funding secured for another 47 charging ports across the LGA
- All chargers to be installed by end of 2025/26 and open to the public 24 hours a day



- Pedestrian safety works
- Traffic calming
- Stormwater drainage upgrade
- \$390,000
- Starts 9 March 2026
- 12 week construction



Holborow Street, Croydon Park – Renewal


- Pedestrian Crossing

- \$900,000
- Starts 23 February 2026
- End of May 2026 completion

- \$305,000
- Started 19 January 2026
