

Terms and Conditions for entering the Summer Reading Challenge 2023-2024

- 1. The Summer Reading Challenge 2023-2024 commences on Monday 20 November 2023 and ends on Sunday 25 February 2024.
- 2. This competition is a game of chance. Winners will be randomly drawn by using the Beanstack drawings software.
- 3. To be eligible for the draw entrants are required to read 12 books, write 2 reviews and complete 4 activities.
- 4. Entry is free and open to all Inner West Library members between the ages of 5-12 years.
- 5. Employees of Inner West Council and their family members are not eligible for the prize draws.
- 6. To enter you must create an account with Beanstack via innerwest.beanstack.com
- 7. All entrants are required to provide their name, email and age for eligibility and for contact if they are a winner.
- 8. Inner West Council's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. Prize winners' names will be announced through Inner West Libraries social media channels.
- 10. Prizes are non-transferable and non-redeemable for cash.
- If a prize winner does not respond within 30 days to Council's email notifying them that they are a winner, Inner West Libraries will award the prize to another valid entrant.
