#### **SUMMARY**

Our Energy Future (OEF) is an initiative of the Southern Sydney Region of Councils (SSROC). It is a key project within the SSROC Renewable Energy Master Plan. The ultimate goal of the Renewable Energy Master Plan is to significantly increase the amount of renewable energy uptake in southern Sydney.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

That the Environment Strategic Reference Group notes:

- 1. The October Inner West solar campaign through Our Energy Future
- 2. That during October there were 182 requests for solar quotes from inner west residents through Our Energy Future

#### **BACKGROUND**

Our Energy Future (OEF) is an initiative of the Southern Sydney Region of Councils (SSROC). It is a key project within the Southern Sydney SSROC Renewable Energy Master Plan. The ultimate goal of the Renewable Energy Master Plan is to significantly increase the amount of renewable energy uptake in southern Sydney. Through Our Energy Future, Inner West Council is offering specialised energy services to inner west residents. There is a dedicated helpline and website: <a href="https://documents.org.au/">ourenergyfuture.org.au/</a>. Residents and businesses can also request quotes directly from approved suppliers.

The Our Energy Future service is run by 'Positive Charge' who are part of the Moreland Energy Foundation Ltd, a not-for-profit organisation set up by Moreland City Council in 2000, to work with the local community to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Through the program, Council has embarked on a dedicated promotional campaign with the aim to increase the number of requests for quotes and eventually the number of solar energy installations and other services. The first Inner West LGA campaign ran for the month of October. A letter from the Mayor was sent out to 15,000 households on 3 October 2017, informing them of the program and inviting them to take part (see attachment). The website and helpline were continuously promoted through Council's social media channels, and in the Council eNews and Enviro eNews.

In addition, Project Manager Rob Kyle had an information stall at the Footprints Ecofestival in August and at Marrickville Festival in October. Staff spoke with festival-goers about the program, gave out information and had a sign-up sheet. The Green Living Centre ran an Intro to Solar workshop on 28 October, attended by 17 people. Our Energy Future will run a Solar Made Simple workshop on 15 November; there are currently 37 people registered out of 40 available spaces.

During October, there were 197 requests for solar quotes from inner west residents and 3 sales orders.
