








Current Status

- Warringah F'way upgrade commenced April 2021
- Geotech on-going
- Preliminary utility works by end of 2021
- WHT Construction early 2022.



 - Cumulative impacts.








- Public health.










Yurulbin Point


- Closure of the Yurulbin Park for 3+ years

Dredging & Immersion








Tunnelling Under Peninsula

The depths, shown in metres, are measured from ground level to the road surface in the tunnel.






Approx. Tunnel Depths

• (50 -60 m






Balmain Leagues Club site

- Noise, dust, lighting & traffic
- Access via Victoria Road:
 - 420 heavy vehicles/day
 - 230 light vehicles/day.




Cumulative Operational Traffic (2037)

<u>"Do Minimum" vs "Do Something Cumlative"</u>

- Additional vehicles on network 12,000 v/day (22%)
- Increased kms travelled by car 96,000 kms/day (68%).
