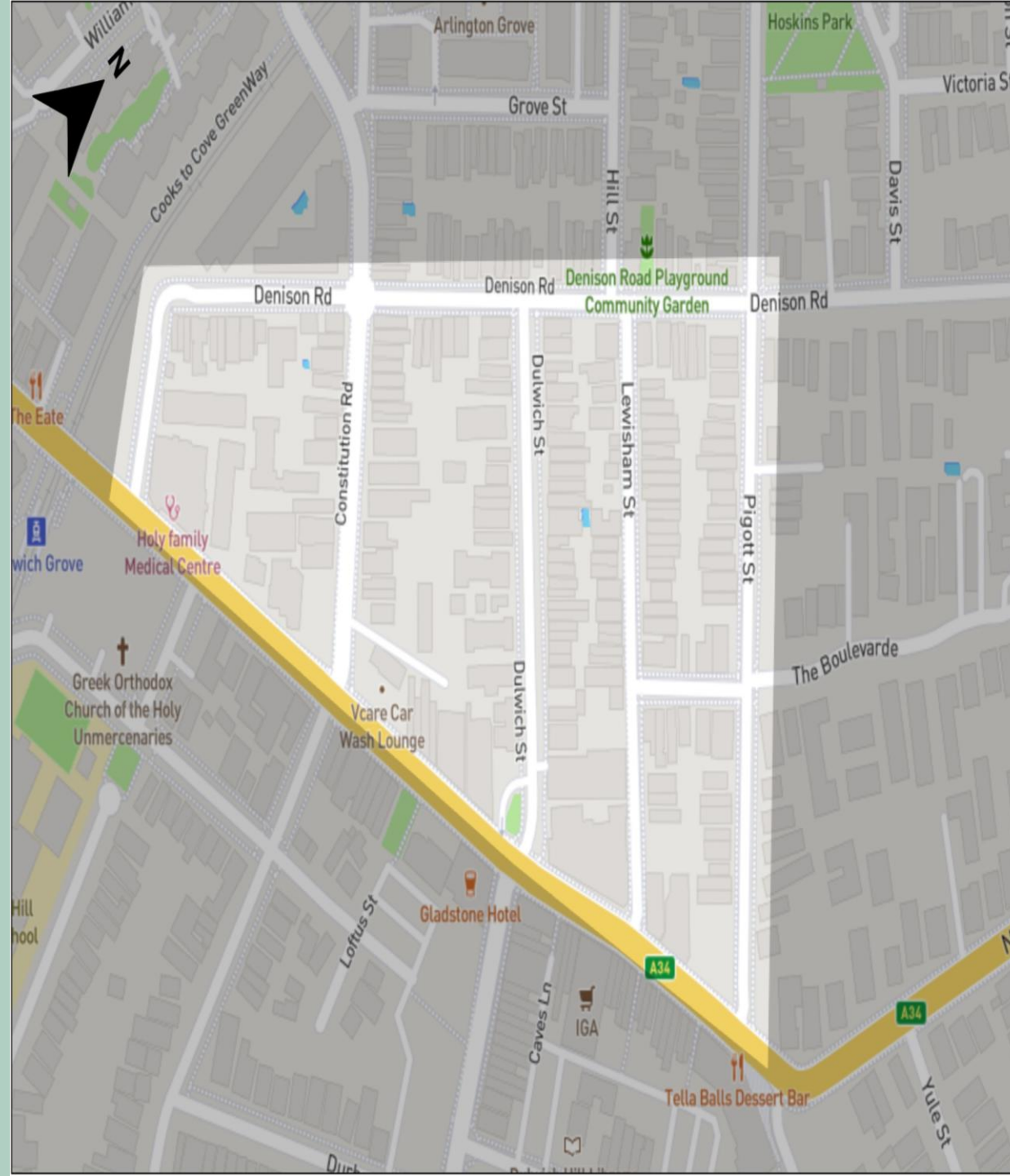

InnerWest@40 – reducing speed limits across your area

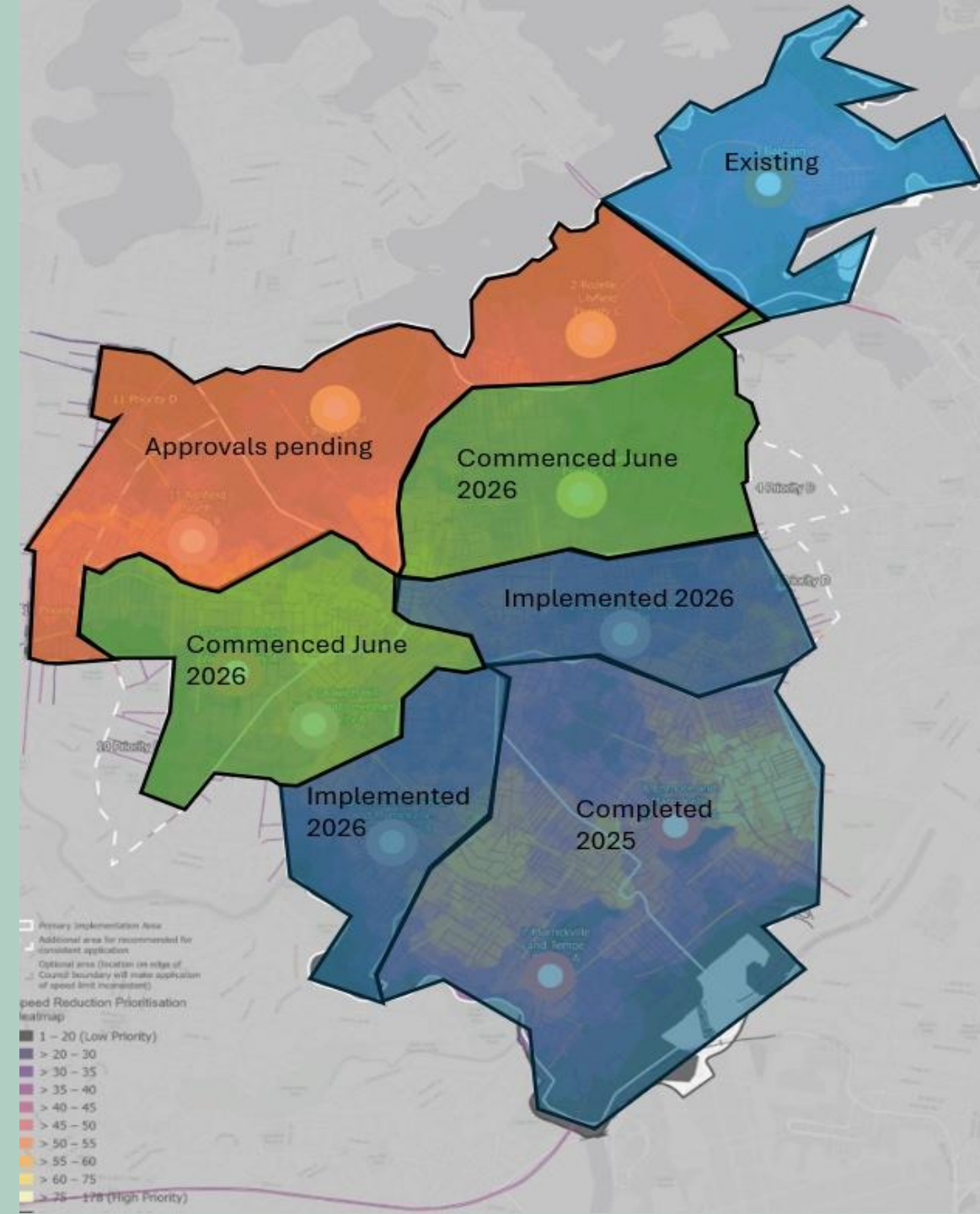
Rollout completed in:

Cardinal Freeman pedestrian improvement works

The works will improve road safety and pedestrian access in the area.

Construction of raised pedestrian crossings are planned at the following sites over September:

- Victoria Street (at Robert St), Ashfield (\$120K)
- Seaview Street (at Yeo Avenue), Ashfield (\$45K)

Completed works:

- Queen Street at Seaview Street & Hillcrest Avenue and Queen Street at Clissold Street (\$346K)
- Clissold Street and Victoria Street between William Street & Victoria (\$168K)
- Clissold Street at Holden Street Robert Street at Holden Street (\$57K)



Dulwich Hill Festival 2026

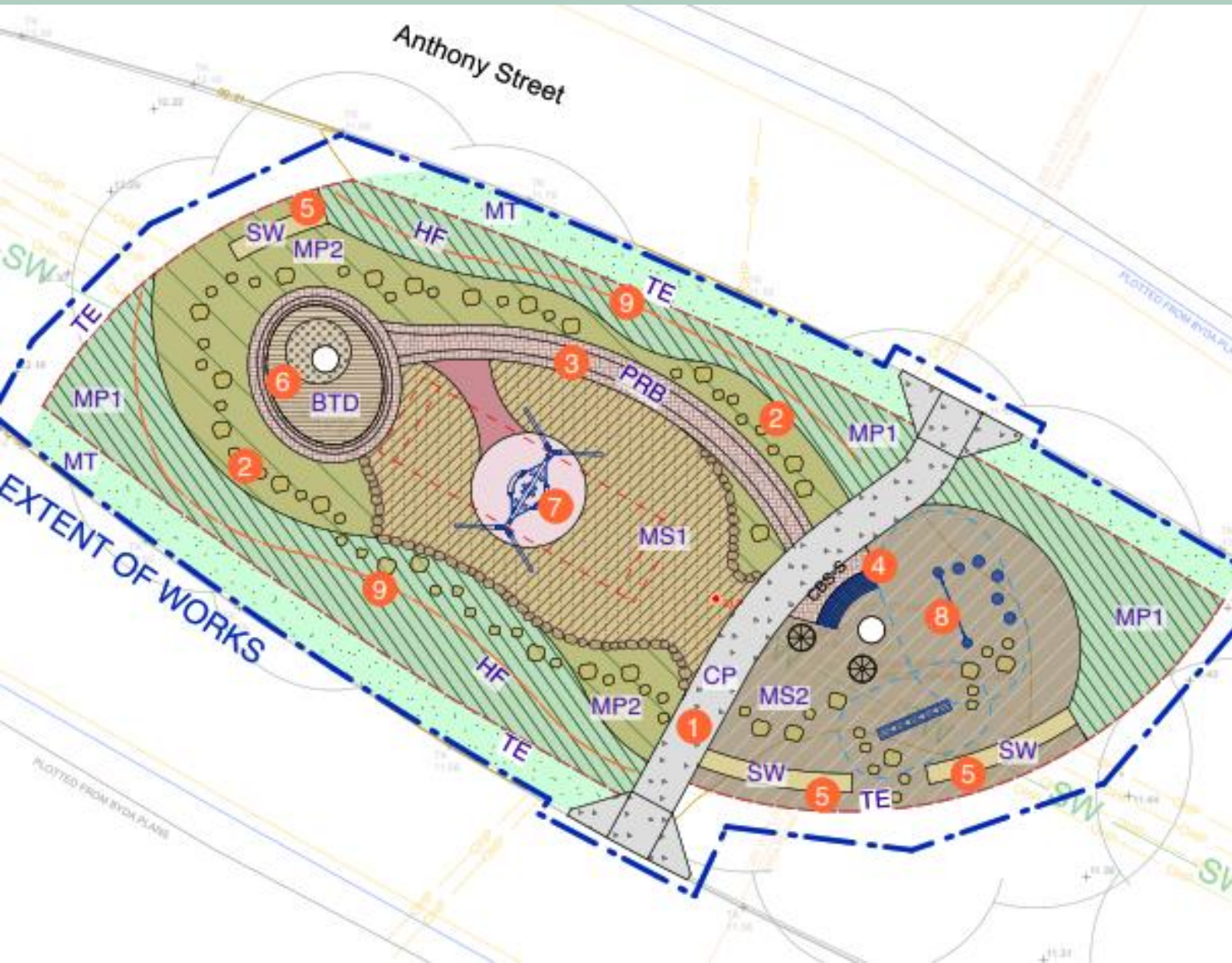
Sunday 20 September

- 2 The boulder loop
- 3 The meandering brick path
- 4 Upgraded seat in the tree's shade
- 5 Perimeter sandstone seating for sitting and enclosure
- 6 Timber deck resting node under the tree
- 7 New swing
- 8 Nature play
- 9 New fence

Upgrades to Albert Parade Reserve*



- 1 New wider accessible path, clear of tree roots
- 2 Rubber softfall access route to play equipment integrated with softfall mulch
- 3 Park seating
- 4 New fitness station
- 5 Existing drinking fountain to be retained, and provided with accessible path
- 6 New multiplay tower
- 7 New see saw rocker
- 8 New rocker
- 9 Existing swing to be retained with new seats
- 10 Existing chin up to be retained
- 11 Nature play
- 12 Open grassed area
- 13 Existing grassed area to be protected
- 14 Mulch at base of existing trees

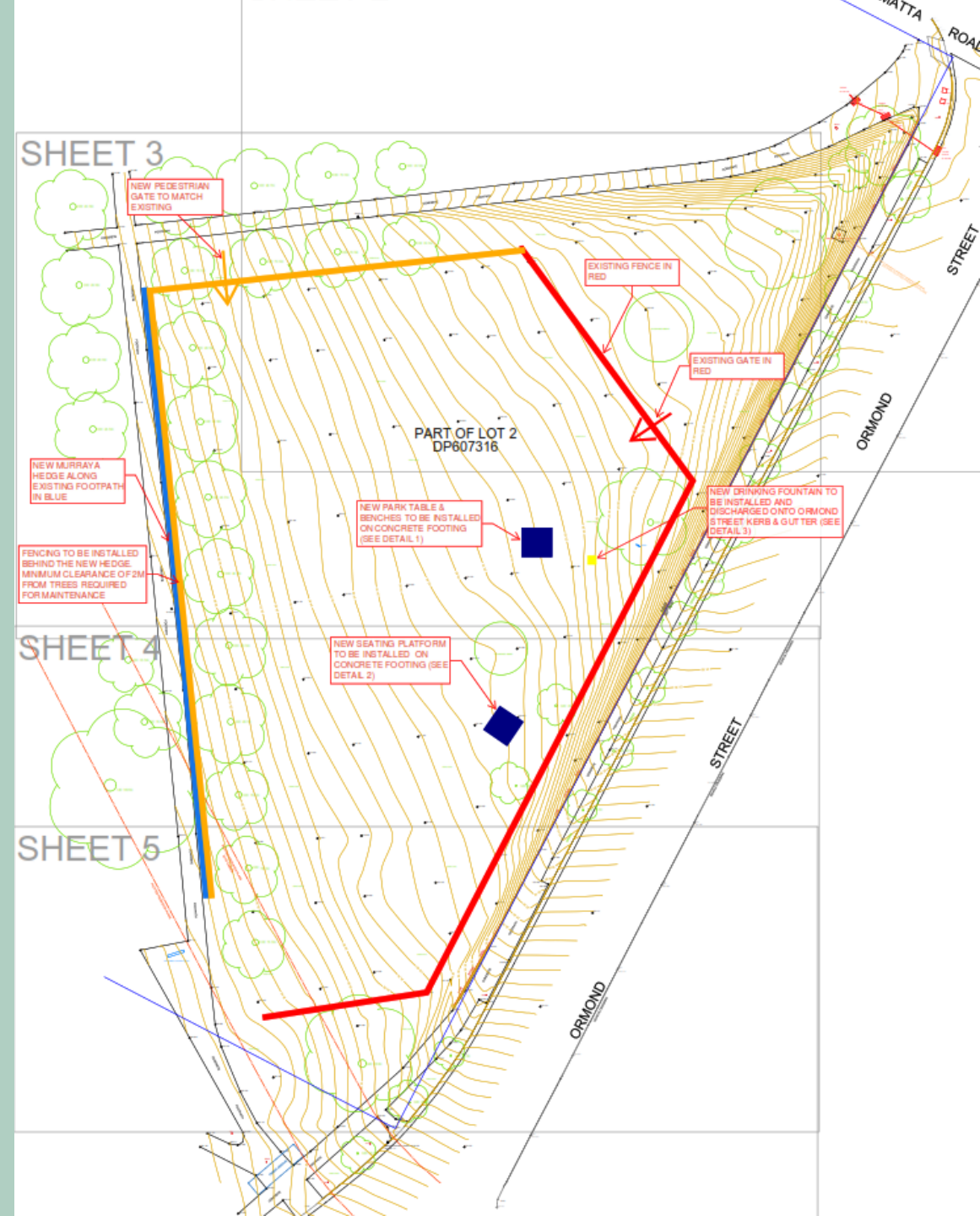
