b) Creative spaces

- Providing affordable creative space is imperative. What's in the Fairer Futures plan/ Community Building plan for creative spaces and infrastructure?
- "Illegal", unofficial, unconventional spaces are important —how do we capture this?
- What support can Council give to current creative space operators who are struggling to stay afloat, but are supporting huge numbers of artists
- Incorporate demographic trends that influence the life cycle career 'exit points' (economic and life stage factors)
- Consider Landbanking, Commbank IQ

c) Other

- o Consider loading areas for musicians
- o Do we know where audiences for Council events are coming from?

2. **Great Inner West Walk (Stephanie Bhim, Reactivate Consulting)**

Six proposed routes have been developed and feedback was sought from the group as arts experts and as local residents. Feedback included:

- o Lilyfield Road:

INNER WEST

- significantly steep for walking, consider a gentler option (hard and easy grades)
- stretch between Rozelle Parklands and Bay Run not so scenic. Suggest Callan Park, connecting to Bay, as alternatives,
- Wharf Road is a good alternative—Writers NSW are located there—writing activations?
- North-south spine:
 - Question the naming of 'Little Italy' – is this holding Norton St back?
 - Food theme: can businesses be incentivised to offer 'tasting' experiences?
 - Art: several Perfect Match murals are located just off this route, as well as Petersham tunnel
 - Are there plans for rest spots and seating?
 - Very long walk – is this achievable as a food route?
 - Workshop opportunities with businesses (eg: florists) to bring this route alive.
- Stanmore to creeks
 - Attractive areas near Railway Ave
- Western Link
 - Sustainability Hub a point of interest

INNER WEST

- Yeo Park with the Survival Memorial not far
- Sydenham to Stanmore
 - Sydenham Road—huge number of live music venues, lends itself to nighttime walks
 - Poor footpath, but upgrades planned
 - Sydney street full of artist studios
- Other: how to get live input from community? Layers of stories
