Subject:	Pymont Bridge Road Cycleway Delivery

Dear Councillors,

The Pymont Bridge Road cycleway marks the final stage of the PRUAIP program, which comprises the following elements:

- A cycleway spanning from Parramatta Road to Booth Street, featuring a combination of on-road and separated pathways on both sides of the street.
- Replacement of the current part-time clearway operating during morning and evening periods.
- Streetscape improvements, including tree planting and the repaving of footpaths.

This project is situated on a State Road overseen by Transport for NSW (TfNSW). Funding has been fully secured via the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI) PRUAIP program and the TfNSW Get NSW Active Transport Funds, with available funds in the order of \$2.6M (PRUAIP \$1.4M and TfNSW \$1.18M).

Although Council was appointed as the lead agency for project delivery, all participating agencies agree that TfNSW is best suited to undertake this work, given that it falls within their jurisdiction.

Accordingly, Council will return the PRUAIP funding to DPHI, conclude the Get NSW Active funding agreement, and assist with the transfer of these funds to TfNSW's internal delivery team.

The project will proceed as planned, maintaining its original objectives. Council officers will have the opportunity to review and comment on plans as key stakeholders. TfNSW will also conduct community consultation to ensure local feedback is gathered.
