

GreenWay construction notice

Electrical works and temporary partial path closure

The GreenWay is a major pedestrian, cycling, and biodiversity corridor linking the Cooks River at Earlwood with the Parramatta River at Iron Cove. We opened the GreenWay shared path in December last year.

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintenance and continuous improvement, we are upgrading electrical cables along one section of the GreenWay. Works include restoration of the artwork lights in the Davis Street tunnel.

When will this work take place?

The works will take place on Monday 11 May (weather permitting), from 7am to 5pm.

Where will this work take place?

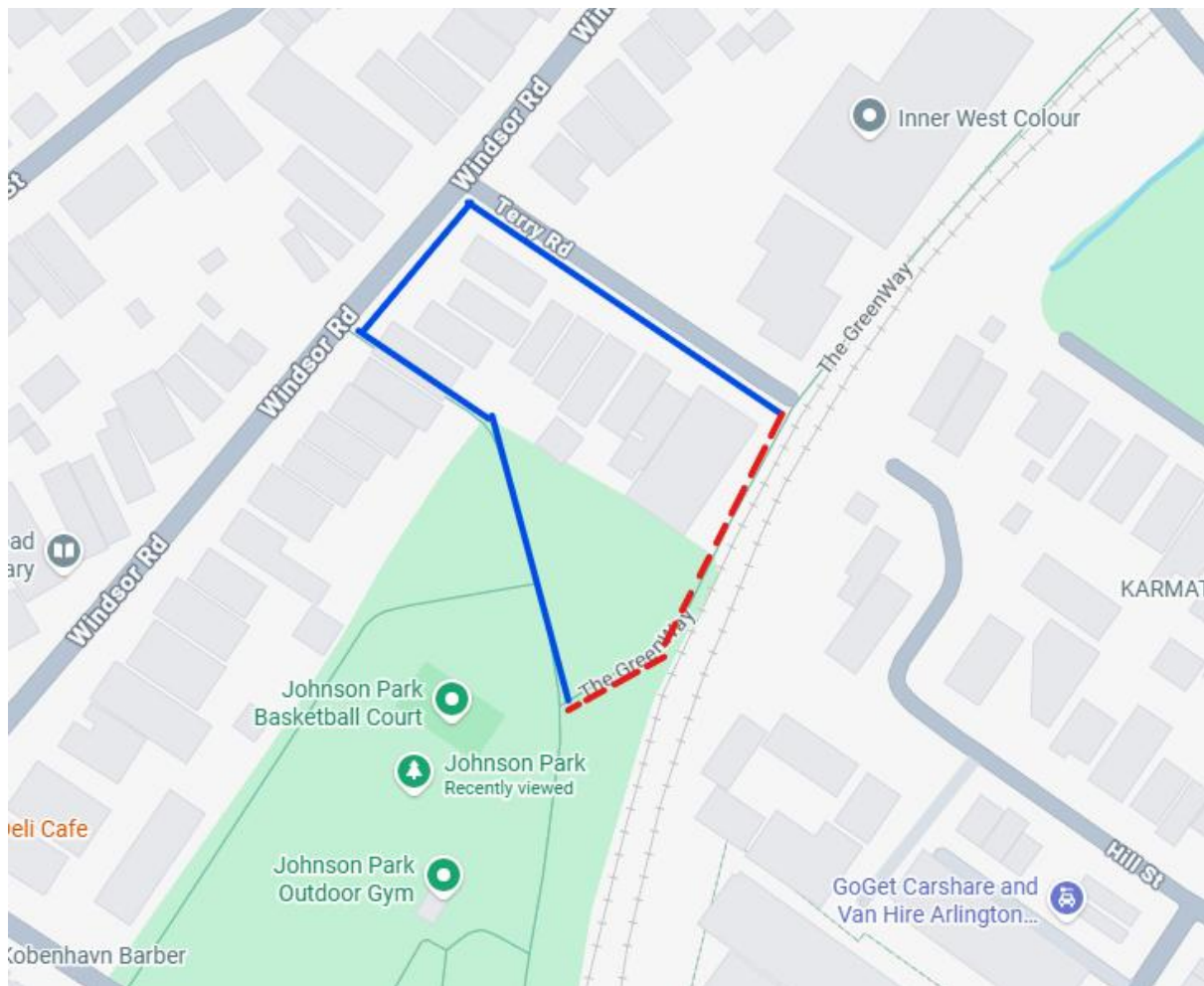
The work will take place on the GreenWay between Terry Road and Johnson Park in Dulwich Hill.

Temporary partial path closure and detour

In order to make the electrical improvements, a number of raised path panels will need to be removed for a limited period during the day. To do this safely, a short detour will be in place for all GreenWay users, while the path panels are removed.
