Your 3 bins:

- Red lid garbage
- Yellow lid recycling
- Green lid FOGO (Food Organics Garden Organics)

Order free:

1. House number stickers to identify your bin
2. Bin stickers – what goes in each bin
3. "Don't dump it – book a clean-up" A4 bin sticker
4. Printed waste collection calendar

Drop-off Facilities

Community Recycling Centres:

Dispose of chemicals and e-waste.

► Leichhardt – 50–54 Moore Street, Leichhardt

Opening hours: Saturday and Sunday,
7:45am to 11:30am, and 1pm to 3:45pm.

► St Peters – 15–17 Unwins Bridge Road, St Peters (Entry at rear, through Bolton Street)

Opening hours: Saturday and Sunday, 8am to 1pm.

Weekend Transfer Station:

Drop off pre-sorted items, including recyclables at
our Weekend Transfer Station, up to 1 cubic metre.

► Leichhardt – 50–54 Moore Street, Leichhardt

Opening hours Saturday and Sunday, 7:45am to
11:30am, and then 1pm to 3:45pm.

Book a clean-up

If items can't be reused, donated or sold, book a free clean-up online or call us. The service is available weekly and collects up to 2 cubic metres. This is available to all residents, tenants, and property owners.

Book clean-ups by category to maximise recycling, as they are collected by different trucks

- Bulky household items
- Mattresses
- Metal and white goods
- Bundled and tied tree branches

Place booked items on the footpath/rear lane the evening before your collection date.

If you live in an apartment, check with your building manager where to place items for clean-up.

Move in checklist

- ☐ Check you have 3 bins – red, yellow, and green lids
- ☐ To FOGO, order a kitchen benchtop bin and compostable liners. Pick up compostable liners (with the seedling logo) from Council service centres and libraries
- ☐ Check your bin collection day online Innerwest.nsw.gov.au/waste-calendar
- ☐ Make sure your bins are marked as yours (houses)
- ☐ Know what goes in each bin
- ☐ Book a free clean-up of broken furniture and household items that can't be reused
- ☐ Drop off excess recycling from your move to the Weekend Transfer Station if it cannot fit in your recycling bin
- ☐ Drop off chemicals and E-waste to a Community Recycling Centre or Chemical Clean-Out and E-Waste event

Move out checklist

- ☐ Declutter and sort items to keep, give away, recycle or dispose
- ☐ List items to sell/give away, post on local pay-it-forward groups or give to charity
- ☐ Check the A-Z list on Council's website for disposal and recycling options
- ☐ Book a clean-up online for broken furniture and items that can't be reused
- ☐ Drop off chemicals and E-waste at the Community Recycling Centre
- ☐ Take excess garbage or recycling to the Weekend Transfer Station
- ☐ Ensure your bins are empty, returned to the property and clean before you move out (houses)
